

## **Title VI Notice to the Public**

Under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, any person who believes he or she has been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice on the basis of race, color, or national origin has the right to file a formal complaint with the County. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with the County Compliance Officer within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence. In addition to its obligations under Title VI, Tompkins County is committed to equally serving all persons in all county programs or activities without discrimination on the basis of race, color, sex, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, religion, age, national origin, alienage, disability, medical condition, military status, familial status, or any other status or category protected by law (federal, state, or Tompkins County local law).



## Title VI Public Notice Notifying the Public of Rights Under Title VI **Tompkins County**

Tompkins County operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Any person who believes she or he has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with Tompkins County or any of the service providers shown below:
